Teethsavers is working hard on two continents. We have a full-time team working village after village, day after day, in Malawi to help the poor and hurting children there. They are helping them dentally, educationally and telling them about the love of Jesus.

In Jinotega, we have Alan Oliva and Dr. Rivera trained and supervising the work of our graduates in their home districts seeing children dentally and telling them about the love of Jesus. Alan and Dr Rivera also assist with work at the Mission Para Cristo where the people of Jinotega are seen medically and told about Jesus.

In San Juan Del Sur, Keith Rodgers and Kelly and their team of Teethsavers are seeing the children in all the schools and villages around San Juan Del Sur, examining and treating them and telling them of Jesus' love. Keith and Kelly will be returning to the States at the end of the year but have trained their team to carry on without them after that. The team's big need will be a vehicle after they leave. Keith and Kelly have a website - hopefornica.org, and are on Facebook.

In Sierra Leone, we have 7 graduates (trained by Dr. Rudd and Dr Patric Davis) seeing the children there and telling them about Jesus. This has just come to fruition this year. Dr. Rafaella Gabassi, a dentist from the United Kingdom with a big heart for the children of Sierra Leone, has joined with us in this effort.

Teethsavers work is being carried on by those trained by Jack in the past in Morocco, Belize, Uganda, Guatemala and more. Jack is currently working on doing some special training for the Dominican Republic.

Teethsaver teams have been busy travelling and doing much around the world. From Sierra Leone to Malawi and Zambia, from Jinotega to San Juan Del Sur in Nicaragua, and more recently, our Executive Director has been making contacts and setting up special educational Teethsavers booths at dental trade shows in San Antonio and San Diego.

All of this world expansion has been wonderful and thousands of children are being helped, BUT Teethsavers has run out of funding and needs your help to carry on. We need \$45,000 to make it through the end of the year. We are especially anxious to begin treating children again in Zambia as we have 8 trained operators there ready to go to the villages and care for the children. This operation is only waiting on funding. It will require \$75,000.

Most people do not think about how life-threatening dental problems can be and do not understand the
